




SI Droid Instructions

1. Before Event

Open SI Droid App on tablet

- Click  symbol (top right) > Manage Database > Backup event to SD card
- Click  symbol > Manage Database > Erase all event data
- Click  symbol > Settings
- Select Name > enter event name (e.g. SBOC Summer League 2 - Oxwich)
- Select Date > enter date of event
- Select Start time/Zero time > This should be 60/120 mins before the first start

Enter Courses

- Select Courses tab > Click + symbol (top right) > enter course details
- Name of course > Green etc
- Enter Control Codes > SI control codes separated by space > e.g. 201 202 etc
- Enter length of course in metres e.g. 3.1km would be 3100
- Enter climb in metres
- Enter each course separately

Enter link to names file

- Once closing date has passed. Ask for the CSV file of entries to be sent to you from Pre-Entries administrator.
- Then send this file from your email to Sbocsboc789@gmail.com
- Log onto the tablet and open gmail to see if the file has arrived. Download it onto the tablet.
- In **SI Droid**, click on settings. Scroll down to find "Lookup of Card Owner". Click on this option.
- Then Tick option: "Fetch owners from own file".
- Click "File with card owners", and this should take you to the downloaded file area. You should see the Pre-entries CSV file for your event. Click on that to link it to the **SI Droid**. You should see a message at bottom of screen showing how many valid runners have been found. This should correspond to the number of entries.
- If not, there are likely to be blank fields for hire card entries. You could amend this after stage a. and enter hire dibber numbers there into the blank fields.

2. On the Day


Set up

- Make sure tablet and Bluetooth printer are both charged
- Connect SI Download station to tablet via micro USB port on top of tablet



Reading the cards

- Open Readout tab in SI Droid
- Ask competitors to insert dibber into download unit
- The results will be stored on the tablet and the competitor will receive a printed copy.
- SI Droid matches the course to the controls punched on the SI Card when it is read. If there is a mismatch check that you have entered the Control Codes correctly for that course or if the runner has mispunched.

Results

- SI Droid will pick up the name, club, age from the start list file.
- Where no name select runner by SI Card number in Results tab >  symbol > enter name > in club field enter Club and Age Class e.g. SBOC M60

3. After Event

- Select Results Tab >  share symbol > Simple Results (HTML) > Share Through Other App > Gmail > Send by email either to yourself or to Niall Reynolds : nm.reynolds@hotmail.co.uk
- Select Results Tab >  share symbol > Results with splits (HTML) > Share Through Other App > Gmail > Send by email either to yourself or to nm.reynolds@hotmail.co.uk
